Parents Please Note: Study Halls are offered only for students that are required to remain on campus and during a class period in which no class is offered that they can take. In most cases, KACS will provide monitors for study halls but can not guarantee a monitor for study hall periods with a low enrollment. KACS policy prohibits students from taking two study halls in a row. Each study hall is a separate cost. Students are limited to no more than two study halls. The administrator may make exceptions to this on a case by case basis. The study hall price is fixed and is the same whether a student needs it just one, two or three days a week.

Apologetics/Worldview is required to graduate from KACS beginning with the 2008 Fall semester. This class must be taken at KACS in order to obtain a King's Academy Diploma.

****Elective Classes** offered in the Super Elective Block may have additional sections offered depending on the number of students wishing to enroll in a class. Elective classes with less than 5 students enrolled may be cancelled and those students enrolled in another elective choice.
